


#### **Your Incubation Team**


Your team should be trained & structured to offer virtual incubation. Bridge has a a team of multicultural professionals that have managed 130+ programs with a great focus on gender balance

Provide a space in which to foster connections between entrepreneurs, mentors and investors. Accessible to all participants for life! They access perks valued in over \$30K, webinars, and events.










### OUR STARTUP'S VIRTUAL INCUBATION JOURNEY MAP IS STRUCTURED AS FOLLOW




How We wanted the incubation to go







